Salkehatchie Commissioning

Pastor: We are part of the fellowship of the unashamed, we have holy spirit power. The dye has been cast, we have stepped over the line. The decision has been made, we are disciples of Christ. We won’t look back, let up, slow down, back away, or be still.

Salkehatchie Missioners: Here am I! Lord, send me.

Congregation: The Lord’s name be praised.

Pastor: Our past is redeemed, our present makes sense, our future is secure. We’re finished and done with low living, sight walking, small planning, smooth knees, colorless dreams, tamed visions, mundane talking, cheap living, and dwarfed goals.
