A box marked Kairos will be in the church workroom to put your wrapped cookies in. **Cookies should be delivered to church no later than noon on or before April 23.**

We will also support the Kairos weekends by sending cards. A Kairos box will be by the Trinity mailboxes in the preschool hallway and a Kairos mailbox will be located in the Fellowship Hallway by the elevator. Please write words of encouragement and include only your first name when signing the cards. Please do not seal the envelopes or place any inserts inside of the cards.

Because of the cost per inmate to provide these weekends, we will be taking monetary donations for the weekends. We appreciate anyway you might help with this mission.

Thank you for your continued support of the Kairos Mission.

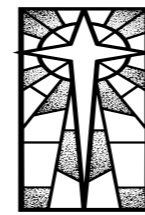
