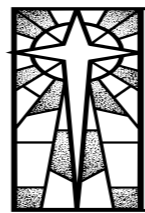

If you need cookie recipes, please contact Jan Rozell. They are accepting store bought cookies in their original packaging, also without powdered sugar, fruit or nuts. The women's favorite are Oreos and they love Kellogg Rice Krispie bars. A box marked Kairos will be in the workroom near the church office to put your wrapped cookies in. **Cookies should be delivered to the church workroom by 3:00 pm on Monday, October 22.**

We will also support the Kairos weekends by sending cards. A Kairos box will be by the Trinity mailboxes in the preschool hallway and a Kairos mailbox will be located in the Fellowship Hallway by the elevator. Please write words of encouragement and include only your first name when signing the cards. Please do not seal the envelopes or place any inserts inside of the cards.

If your children enjoy coloring, they love to get placemats on white construction paper, 12x18." Use only crayons and do not place stickers on them. Your child can sign their first name and please write "Jesus Loves You" on them.
