With the expected cold nights and cooler weather in the forecast, you may want to bring a light jacket or coat for your comfort until the changeover to heat has been made.

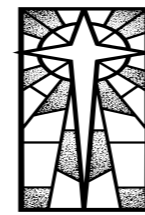

## UMW Sponsored Fall Tea

**Women, Men, Youth. All Are Welcome!**

The speakers for this year's tea are Jeuel Esmacher, one of the women whose World War II work in military intelligence is told in the fascinating book "Code Girls" by Liza Mundy, and her friend Kathryn Smith, author of "The Gatekeeper: Missy LeHand, FDR and the Untold Story of the Partnership that Defined a Presidency" and "A Necessary War: Anderson County Residents Remember World War II," which includes a full chapter on Jeuel. Kathryn will give a brief summary of "Code Girls" and then interview Jeuel about her war-time experiences. Jeuel grew up in Starr, graduated from Winthrop College, and was invited to serve her country in 1944 as a cryptanalyst for the army in Washington, D.C. She has many stories to share about her experiences there, including being among the celebration on the streets of the capital on V-J Day. Copies of "Code Girls" and Kathryn's books will be available for sale and signature. Jeuel recently turned 94 and has decided to "retire" from public speaking after this presentation, so don't miss it.
