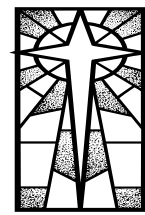

Overnight hosting: involves bringing your pillow and spending the night from 8pm – 6:30am. Bedding and linens are provided, or you may bring your own.

Setup/take down involves setting up the beds in the classrooms above the gym on November 18 and removing the beds and placing them on the Family Promise Trailer on November 25.
