Registration for 2018-2019

Registration for in-house families is Monday, January 29. If you currently have a child enrolled in Trinity you are considered in-house. All in-house families are guaranteed a spot, but I can not guarantee that it will be your first choice. We will start taking applications at 8 am. **Applications will not be accepted before 8 am Monday, January 30.** Do not send Enrollment forms to school in your child's bookbag, registration must be completed in person!

As the weather changes:

Please remember to label, coats, hats, gloves, etc. so that we know who to return lost items to. Also, if your child has a change of clothes in his or her bookbag, check to make sure it is appropriate for the colder weather.

Car Seats:

All students need to be in a appropriate, properly installed carseat. The SC guidelines are:

Children under 2 years old must be in a rear-facing child safety seat in a rear passenger seat of the vehicle unless the child exceeds the manufacturer's weight or height limits.

Children 2 years old and over must be in a forward-facing child safety seat in a rear passenger seat until they exceed the manufacturer's weight and height limits.

Children at least 4 years old, must be in a belt-positioning booster seat in a rear passenger seat. Booster seats are required to use a lap and shoulder strap.
